### **DA McMahon: Staten Island Woman Indicted for Murder of Infant**

*\*\* Gloria Fields systematically tortured toddler she was babysitting, slowly killing him \*\*\**

STATEN ISLAND, NY – Richmond County District Attorney Michael E. McMahon today announced that GLORIA FIELDS has been indicted on charges including Murder in the First Degree, Aggravated Murder and Murder in the Second Degree, among other charges, for torturing and killing 17-month-old Anthony Delgado.

“The grand jury has charged defendant with Murder in the First Degree, having found reasonable cause to conclude that the defendant caused the death of her 17- month-old victim in an especially cruel and wanton manner. In so charging, the grand jury recognized, as the statute requires, that the defendant had tortured the child prior to his death,” said District Attorney Michael E. McMahon.

According to the 12-count indictment and documents filed in court, on or about and between Jan. 19 and Jan. 21, 2016, GLORIA FIELDS, 31, intentionally caused the death of 17-month-old Anthony Delgado by blunt force trauma to the baby’s head, as well as by shaking him, and/or by slamming or throwing the child so as to impact the child’s head on a hard surface or object, and/or by slamming his head into the ground while the child was strapped in a stroller. The defendant also inserted a pencil into the child’s anus and rectum for several days causing lacerations to the anus, rectum and perforation of internal organs. The child’s injuries were sustained over a course of the three days and his injuries were multitudinous, with injuries covering all of the child’s body with the exception of his feet. The incidents occurred at various times inside of 195 Steuben St., SI NY and inside of Buffalo Exchange, 332 E.11th Street, NY NY.

FIELDS was arraigned in State Supreme Court, St. George before Justice Stephen J. Rooney.  
The case is being prosecuted by ADA Ann Thompson.
